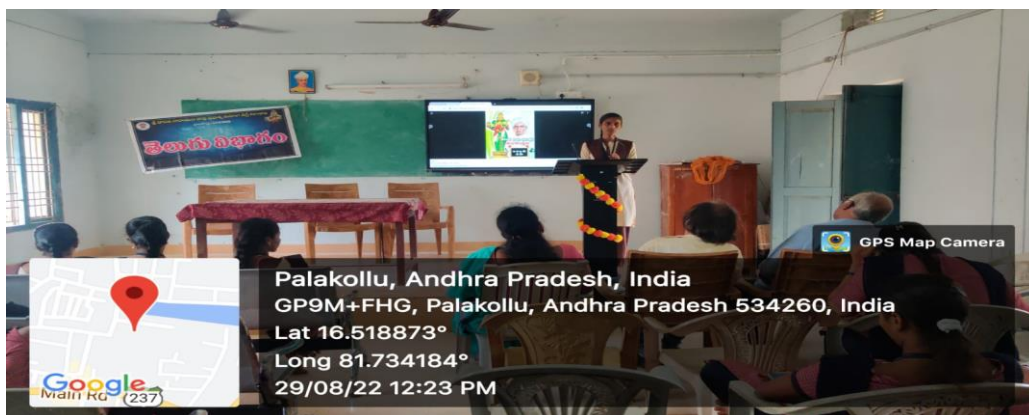

1.NEWS FROM DEPARTMENTS

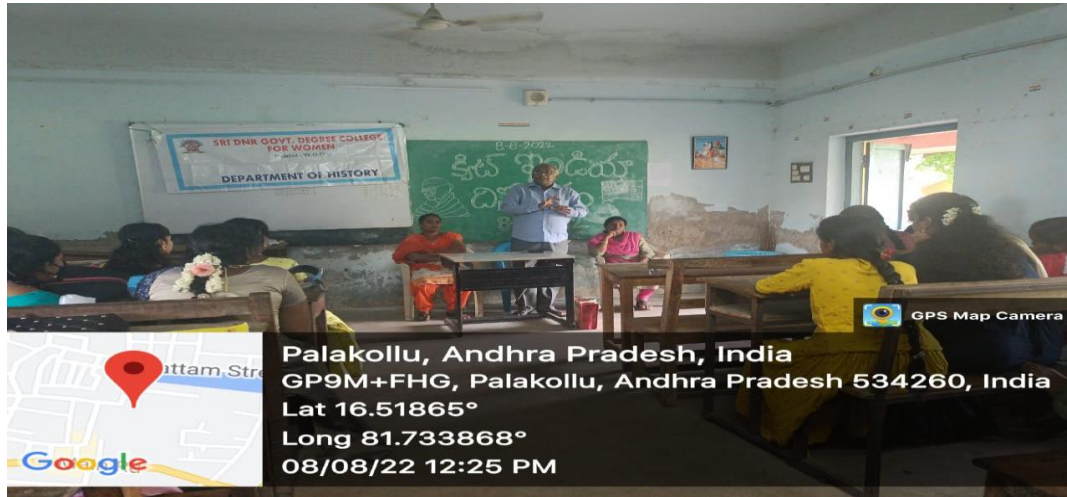
1.Telugu Basha Dinotsavam:-

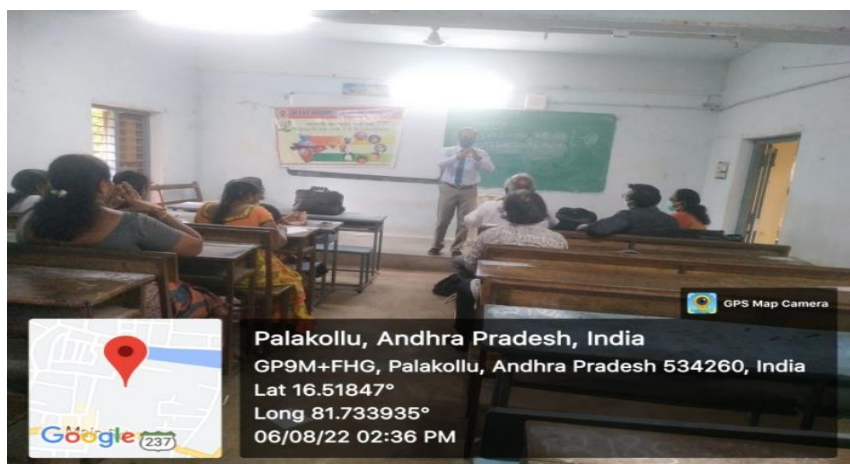
3.Department of Economics:-

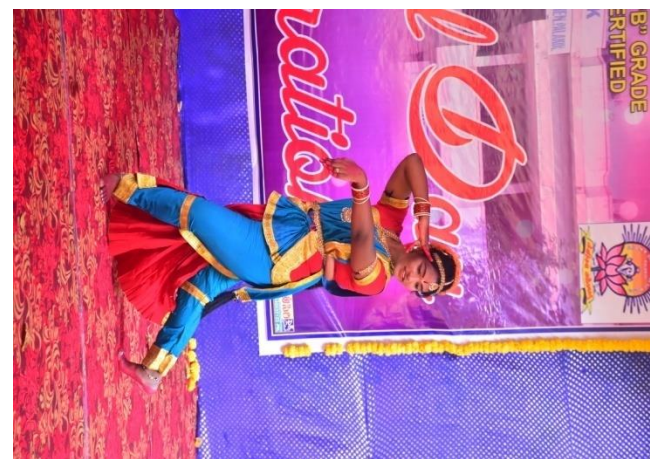




9. Annual Day Celebrations:-
